Some Destinations:

National Museum of Denmark: Denmark's largest museum of cultural history, comprising the histories of Danish and foreign cultures alike.

+

Viking Ship Museum, Roskilde: Five original Viking ships recovered from Roskilde Fjord in 1962 stand majestically with the fjord as a living backdrop.

+

Hedeby: Key Viking trading city active throughout the Viking Age. Its strategic location in Schleswig, Germany, linked Baltic Sea trade routes to the North Sea via a short overland portage.

+

Aggersborg Viking Fortress: Largest of Denmark's Viking ring castles built by King Harald Bluetooth, and Denmark's largest archaeological feature, with an inner diameter of 240 meters.

+

Jelling, the Home of Viking Kings: King Harald Bluetooth and his father, Gorm the Old, installed large stones with runic inscriptions and ruled their kingdom from here. In 2021, named the best tourism project in Europe! It's also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
